

2011 Team USA Selection Process

The selection process will be five (5) shoots for Sporting and five (5) shoots for Fitasc starting in 2010 (Only the main event is considered with the exception of the National Sporting Championship FITASC and US Open FITASC).

These shoots will be as follows:

Sporting

National Championship – NSC – Oct. 26-31, 2010

US Open – The Willows – June 1-6, 2010

Masters Cup – M & M – May 14-16, 2010

Gamaliel Cup – Tennessee Clay Target Complex - April 15-18, 2010

Western Open – Top Gun Club - August 5-8, 2010

World English Sporting will be used when in the US

Starting in 2011 shoots other than the Nationals, US Open and World English (when in US) will be open for bid proposals.

FITASC

North American Fitasc Grand Prix – Claythorne Lodge – June 18-20, 2010

North American Fitasc Championship – Dogwood Hollow – Mar 25-28, 2010

Fitasc Nationals – Rio Brazos – Mar 11-14, 2010

US Open Fitasc – The Willows – June 1-6, 2010

National Championship Fitasc – NSC – Oct. 24-31, 2010 (Shooters not in M or AA and trying to make the Team would shoot in concurrent instead of class so that ALL shoot the same layouts)

Points will be awarded 10 down to 1. In each of these shoots the high score and all ties in each division would receive 10 points, 2nd high score and all ties 9 points, etc. Only four (4) shoots would count in case an unforeseen event makes attendance impossible for one of them or the best four scores if all five are shot. These point totals would be posted on the website within a reasonable time after each shoot so everyone would know how they stand throughout the year.

We will run the World Cup points system in the background to break any ties for all shooters competing in any selection shoots. Their top scores will be used for a maximum of four (4) shoots.
