

**As of January 20, 2010 the end of year review has been run and the 2009 target year is completed. 2010 shoot year information will show up on the NSCA website on January 25, 2010.**

All 2010 class cards will be mailed 1<sup>st</sup> class postage on Friday, January 22, 2010.

All shooters who fit all of the following criteria were moved down 1 class.

- a minimum of 300 targets shot during the 2009 shoot year
- have 0 punches earned during the 2009 shoot year
- started and ended in the same class during the 2009 shoot year
- fit within the rank in class percentages chosen by the Classification Committee for your class

You will now see your new 2010 class when you look at your information on the NSCA website. If you were down classed during the end of year review you will see that you were moved down one class for the 2010 shoot year.

Any earned punches in your 2009 class were carried over to the 2010 shoot year as long as you did not earn enough punches to move up in class by the end of the shoot year.

Any punches earned during the **2008** shoot year that were carried over to the 2009 shoot year **have been dropped**, if you did not earn enough punches to move up in class during the 2009 shoot year. Carry over punches only carry over for 1 year.

If you were down classed and wish to remain in your old 2009 class, please return your class refusal form, located at the bottom of your class card, to NSCA Headquarters. We will make the correction and send an updated 2010 class card to you.

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE!**

### **Only for those members who have been **down-classed** at the end-of-year review**

All NSCA registered events shot during the 2009 shoot year that were reported to Headquarters, were input into our computer system and used to determine the outcome of this review. Printed on your new 2010 classification card, you will find the data (shoot history) that we had available to us at the time of the review. *If you attended a registered tournament after December 31, 2009, this tournament is not on your 2010 class card. If you entered that tournament in your old higher class, and received 1 or more punches before receiving your new 2010 class card; the down-class at end-of-year review is **VOIDED!** If you were down-classed at the 2009 end-of-year review, and won any punches after December 31, 2009, you must return your 2010 classification card immediately and indicate the event where the punches were earned (please include the club name and shoot date).* We will send you an updated 2010 class card.

**Please note:** All award corrections must be sent to NSCA Headquarters by the shoot management where the shoot was held. **Awards (HOA, M2, Vet 4, LY1, etc.) are NOT used in calculating your All American Points, All Zone Points or All State Points!**

**All correction requests must be made in writing on your 2010 class card and returned to NSCA Headquarters.**
